ITINERARY

Day 1	<p>Arrive Kota Kinabalu Airport. Capital city of Sabah, Malaysia and famously known around the world as “The Land Below the Wind” Meet & Greet and transfer to check-in Le Meridien Hotel - located in the city center and very convenience should the guest wish to stroll around for shopping and entertainment. Rest Day, free at leisure</p>	
Day 2	<p>Buffet breakfast at hotel, and then proceed to Sabah Golf & Country Club for 18 holes Golf. Situated along Jalan Kolam 10 minutes drive from the Kota Kinabalu City. Sabah's oldest 18-hole golf course, which opened for play in 1976.</p> <p>This challenging par 72, 6335m-championship course was designed by <i>Robert Muir Graves</i> and acknowledged as one of South East Asia's toughest courses. The longest and probably the most difficult hole is Hole 14 par 5, 625 yards but according to the locals, brain presides over brawn here.</p>	
Day 3	<p>Buffet breakfast at hotel, and then proceed to Karambunai Golf & Country Club for 18 holes Golf. It is located about 30 kilometers or a half-hour's drive from Kota Kinabalu City.</p> <p>This is a beautifully crafted 18-hole 6173m golf course designed by renowned American golf architect <i>Ronald Fream</i>. Stretching from the edge of low hills and reaching towards the sandy beaches, this par 72 championship course requires both strength and strategy from the golfer with its numerous dogleg holes, meandering waterways, bunkers and not to mention the ocean winds.</p>	
Day 4	<p>Buffet breakfast at hotel, and then proceed to Dalit Bay Golf & Country Club for 18 holes Golf. This golf course designed by Ted Parslow is located 35 kilometers (40 minutes drive away) from Kota Kinabalu. This 18-hole, par-72 golf course occupies a 6369 meter stretch of land.</p>	
Day 5	<p>Buffet breakfast at hotel, free for own leisure until transfer to airport for flight departure. END OF TOUR</p>
